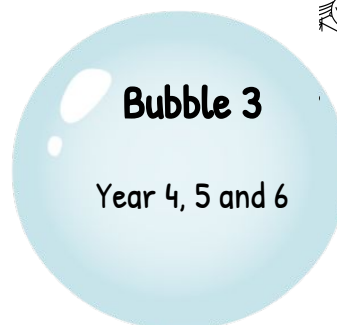
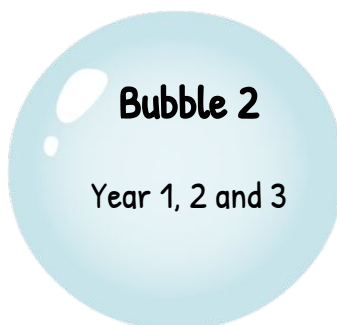
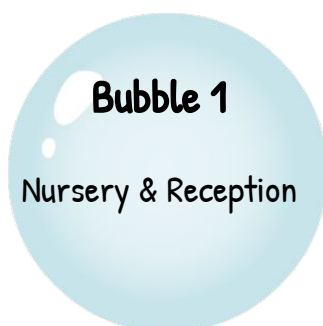


From March 8th 2021, **all** children will be required in school.

Information below will answer any of your questions and give all details for their return.

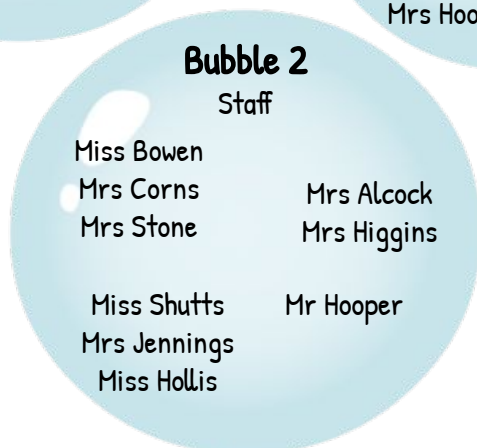
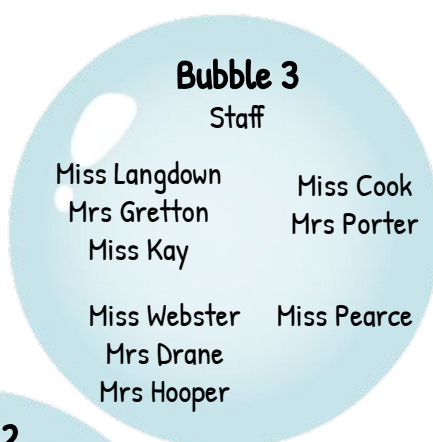
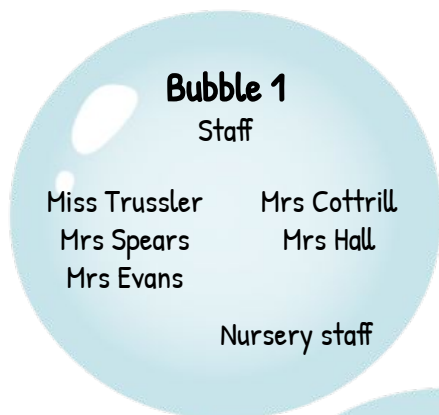
Bubbles

Children will be in the following bubbles depending on their year group:



Break times, lunch time and staff will be kept separate to maintain bubbles.

Each bubble will have allocated staff. These will not change unless there are exceptional circumstances that need to be accounted for.



What won't be in use in these bubbles?

- All soft furnishings have been removed from classrooms.
- The Sunflower room will be out of bounds.
- Nurture sessions will be delivered in the classroom and as designated interventions.
- Children will not be able to self choose books from the library.
- Books will be selected and sent home.
- All other reading books will continue to be sent home.

Gates Open: 8.40am

A one-way system has been designed through the school site:

- Entering at the **large black double gates**, walking to the left
- Through the **small silver gate** onto the **field walkway**
- Right onto the back playground
- Exiting on the far right corner via the **yellow gate**
- Through the **green side gate**, and exiting the site via the **smaller black gate onto the footpath**



As children filter into school, parents continue around the one-way route off site, no waiting/congregating will be permitted. Messages to staff must be passed via email or to the member of SLT on the gate.

Reception class - enter via usual silver gate (no need to participate in full loop unless dropping off/collecting siblings)

Year 1, 2 and 3 (Bubble 2) - enter via classroom exterior door

Year 4, 5 and 6 (Bubble 3) - enter via KS2 door up the steps

Collection: **Gates Open 2.55pm**

Collection from 3.00pm

Gates Close 3.15pm

Reception class - queuing on front playground

Year 1 and 2 - exit via classroom exterior door

Year 3 - exit via classroom exterior door, lining up on KS2 playground

Year 4, 5 and 6 - exit via KS2 ramp, lining up on KS2 playground

There is **no parking** on the school staff car park.

Please use the council car park next to the field to reduce public highway traffic

Wrap around care

Breakfast club and afterschool club will begin on Monday 8th March 2021.

All bookings must be made in advance via ParentPay.

Bookings will not be accepted after the Wednesday of the previous week.

For example: if you require breakfast club or afterschool club from 8th March 2021, this must be booked by 3rd March 2021.

Please note: ALL children will be provided with wrap around care in the hall. There will be designated areas within the hall for each bubble.

Items from home

Children's bags: Please ensure your child's bag is of suitable size (book bag size, not too large!)

Children will be required to bring:

- Water bottle
- Planner
- Reading book
- Lunch and snack (if necessary)
- Rec - fruit provided
- P.E kit to remain in school for the week
