- 6. I don't keep **SECRETS** just because someone asks me to
- 7. I don't change **CLOTHES** in front of a camera
- 8. I am **RESPONSIBLE** so never share private information
- 9. I am KIND and polite to everyone
- 10. I TELL a trusted adult if I'm worried, scared or just not sure
